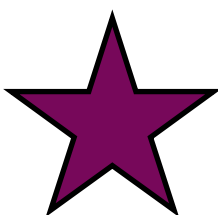

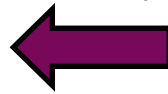
Life on the Sea

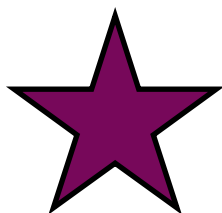
